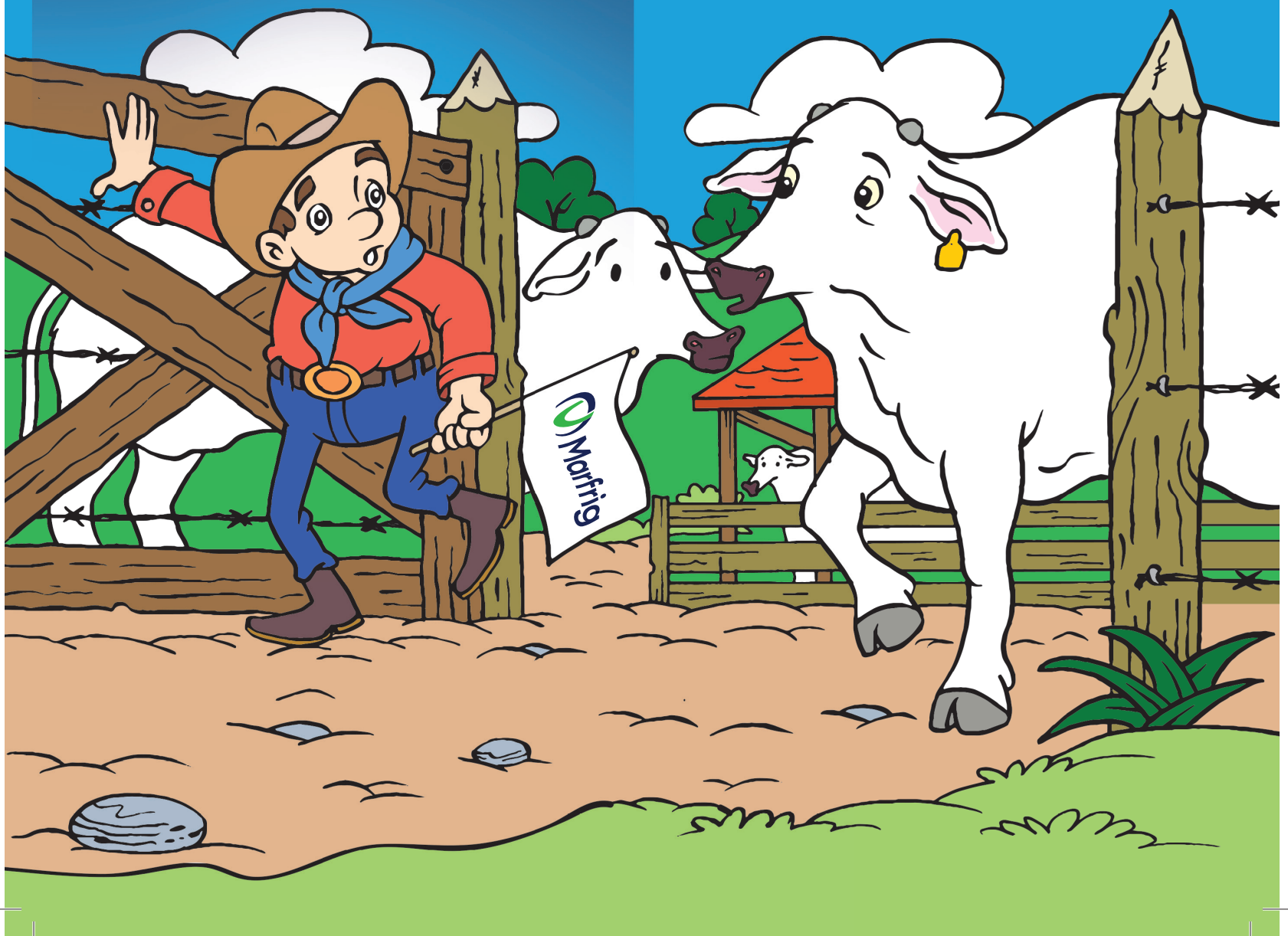


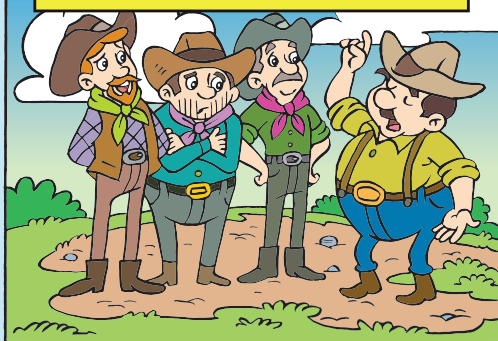

ANIMAL WELFARE



ORGANIZE THE ROLE OF EACH CATTLE HANDLER DURING HANDLING SO THAT THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE IS SUFFICIENT TO CARRY OUT THE WORK.



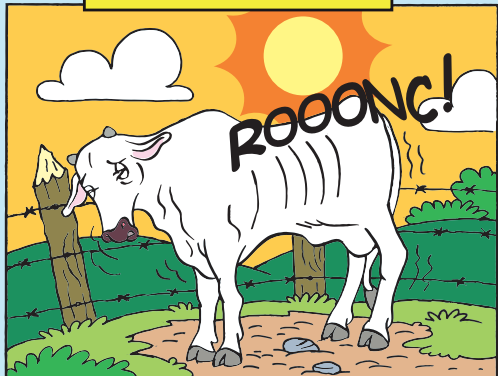
CHECK WHETHER THE GATES ARE IN GOOD CONDITION AND ABLE TO OPEN AND CLOSE WITHOUT DIFFICULTY TO AVOID BRUISING IN ANIMALS.



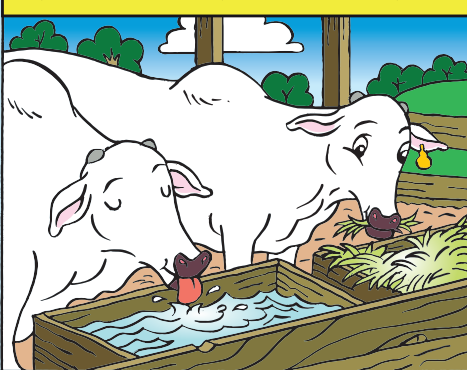
ANIMALS FROM DISTANT PASTURES MUST BE TAKEN THE DAY BEFORE TO THE LAIRAGE WHERE THEY WILL BE LOADED.



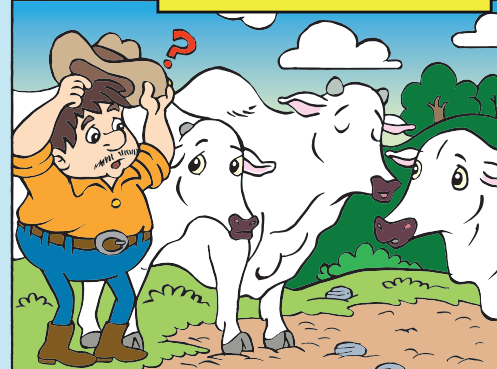
DO NOT LET ANIMALS GO HUNGRY OR THIRSTY.



ACCOMMODATE THE ANIMALS IN LAIRAGES IN GOOD CONDITIONS, WITH CLEAN WATER AVAILABLE, AND RESPECT THE LIMIT OF ANIMALS IN THE LAIRAGES TO AVOID OVERCROWDING.



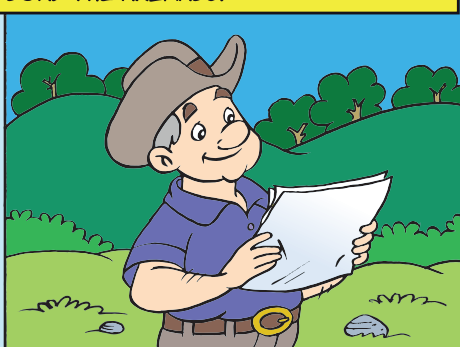
DO NOT MIX DIFFERENT CATEGORIES OF ANIMALS.



BEFORE LOADING, CHECK IF ALL ANIMALS ARE AND HAVE BEEN CORRECTLY IDENTIFIED.



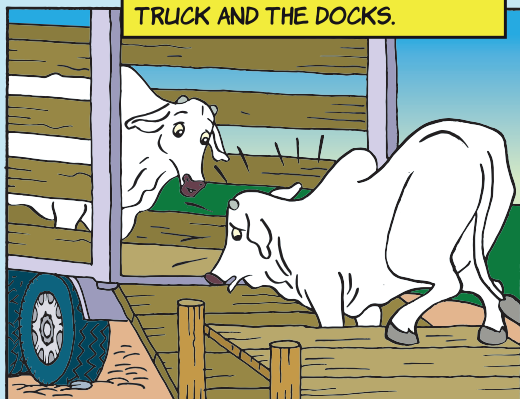
MAKE SURE THAT ALL DOCUMENTS ARE IN ORDER BEFORE STARTING TO LOAD THE ANIMALS.



BEFORE LOADING STARTS, MAKE SURE THAT ALL ANIMALS HAVE RECEIVED THE REQUIRED VACCINES AND DRUGS AND THAT THE WITHDRAWAL PERIODS STATED IN THEIR PACKAGE INSERTS HAVE BEEN RESPECTED. USE ANTIBIOTICS ONLY IF RECOMMENDED BY THE VETERINARIAN.



PARK THE VEHICLE CORRECTLY. LEAVE NO SPACE BETWEEN THE TRUCK AND THE DOCKS.



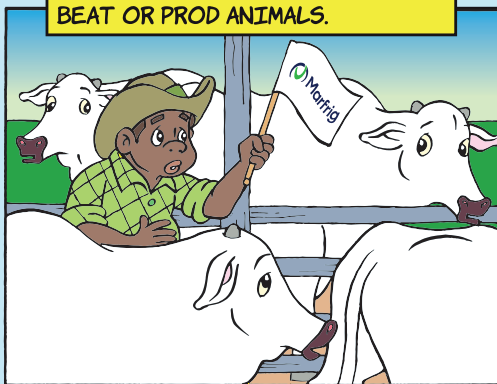
DO NOT PERFORM OTHER TASKS OR ACTIVITIES WHILE HANDLING THE ANIMALS.



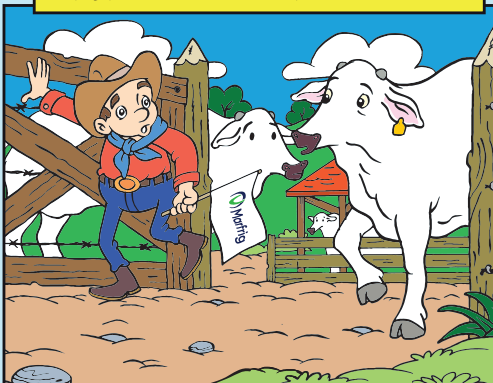
DO NOT USE PRODS, STICKS OR ELECTRIC GOADS TO GUIDE ANIMALS.



USE FLAGS AS AN EXTENSION OF YOUR ARMS AND NOT AS AN INSTRUMENT OF AGGRESSION TO BEAT OR PROD ANIMALS.



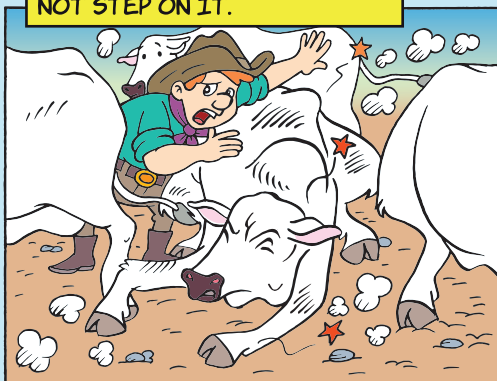
WHEN THERE ARE AGITATED ANIMALS, ASK A CATTLE HANDLER TO NARROW THEIR PASSAGE AT THE GATE.



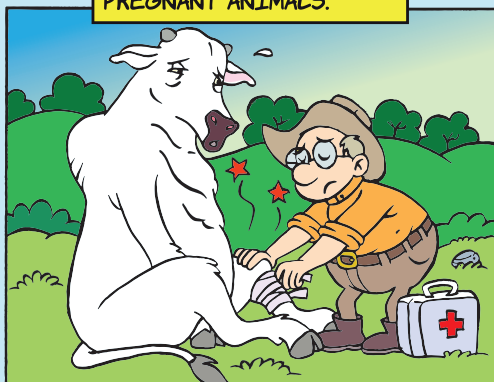
DO NOT HARM ANIMALS WITH PRODS OR ANY INSTRUMENT THAT CAUSES PAIN.



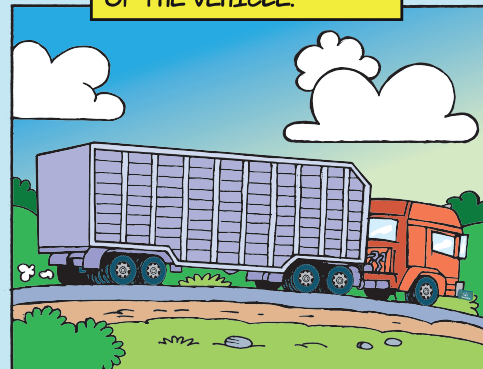
IF ANY ANIMALS FALL DURING LOADING, STOP AND LIFT THIS ANIMAL, SO THAT OTHERS DO NOT STEP ON IT.



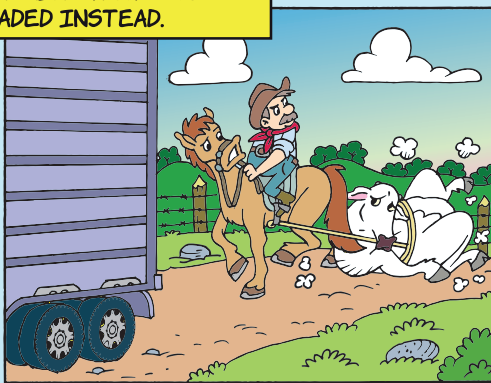
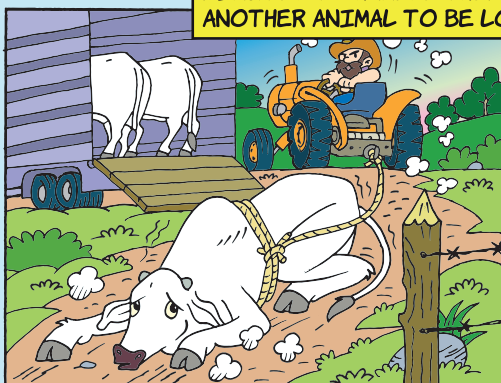
DO NOT LOAD SICK OR PREGNANT ANIMALS.



RESPECT THE CAPACITY OF EACH COMPARTMENT OF THE VEHICLE.



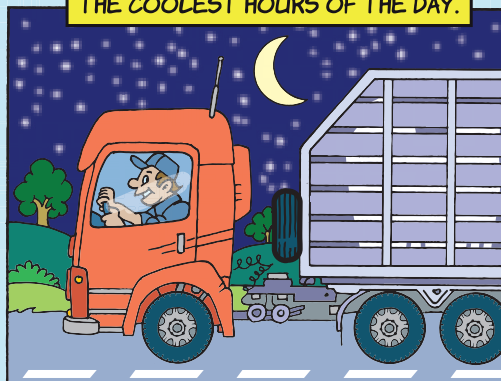
ANIMALS MUST NOT BE DRAGGED. IF THEY REFUSE TO BE LOADED, WAIT APPROXIMATELY 20 MINUTES TO HANDLE THEM AGAIN OR CHOOSE ANOTHER ANIMAL TO BE LOADED INSTEAD.



CHECK IF THE FARM'S INTERNAL ROADS ARE IN GOOD CONDITION AND TRANSPORT THE ANIMALS UNDISTURBEDLY.



TRANSPORT THE ANIMALS DURING THE COOLEST HOURS OF THE DAY.



WHEN THE ANIMALS ARE SEPARATED IN THE LAIRAGE, TAKE THE ANIMALS THAT WILL NOT BE LOADED BACK TO THE PASTURE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.
